



World's First IVF Baby








Extra-Corporeal Gametes










US-Hyperstimulated Ovary




Egg Retrieval

Blastocyst




Cryopreservation Techniques

- Ultrarapid vitrification




Gamete Donation

Egg Donation

- Recruited for directed donation, banked eggs or known donor
- Contract
- Informed Consent
- Screening (medical and psychological), COH, monitoring, trigger and retrieval
- Payment & follow-up

Sperm Donation

- Anonymously donated sperm from cryobank or sperm provided by known donor
- Selection from bank's profiles
- Contract if known donor
- Sperm provided to recipient's fertility center
- Used for IUI or IVF



SURROGACY

- Two types
 - Same anticipated family building outcome
 - Different process



Gestational Surrogacy - Egg & Sperm Donors contract Gestational Mother's Gestational mother Egg Donor child Anonymous sperm donor Father Father's wife

Federal Law and ART

- USA has no central authority regulating ART
- Some federal oversight in areas affecting ART
 - FDA: donation/provision of human tissue
 - CDC: reporting requirements
 - Stem cell research prohibitions & restrictions
 - HIPAA: protecting private health information
 - DOS: Immigration



Fifty States, Fifty Different Laws


- Law varies widely among the 50 states

- Still others have no laws on point.







